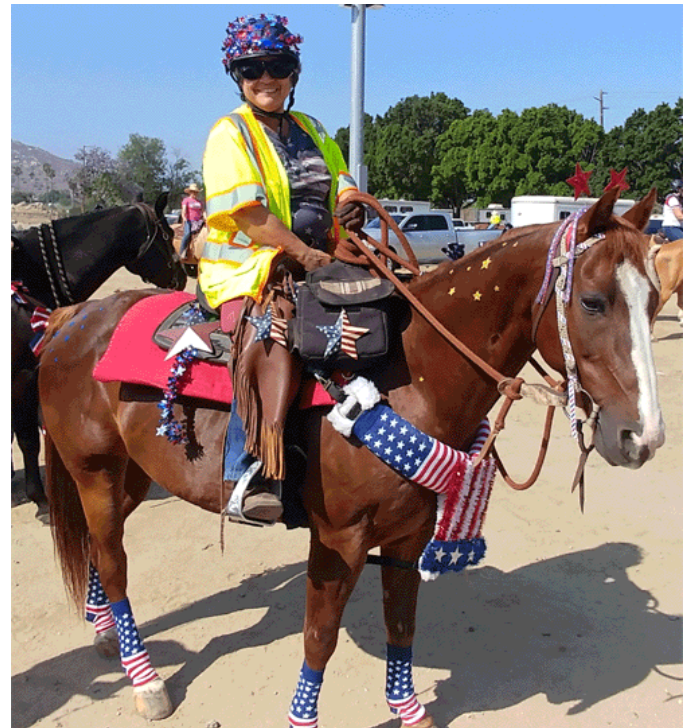


July 4th Ride

Santa Margarita Preserve

Santa Margarita County Preserve is 221 acres and is part of the County of San Diego Multiple Species Conservation Program. The property was acquired in 1992 to preserve the resources and picturesque scenery of the Santa Margarita Valley, while providing additional public trails in the community of Fallbrook.

The lush river corridor provides wildlife a place to naturally forage and make their homes. Raptors are a common site over head or perched in trees. Deer and other large mammals rely on the river for their water. Now preserved in perpetuity, this stretch of the river valley defines the natural beauty of Fallbrook and San Diego County.

The trails are open for multiple use; horseback riding, hiking and mountain biking. To the north the trails connects with the Fallbrook Public Utility Districts trails. To the west the preserve is buffered by Camp Pendleton.




Our ride will stage at 9:00am and leave at 9:30am and be about 3 hours long. This would be considered a "moderate" ride with some water crossings.

There is a very nice big staging area with picnic tables, shade, a port-a-potty, water, and 3 corrals for people who's horses don't tie to trailers. Bring a lunch... we'll have a sit down, relax and eat lunch after the ride.

Directions: Live Oak County Park - 37385 De Luz Rd., Fallbrook, CA 92028. • 760.728.2303
 From the 91 freeway & 15 freeway, go south toward San Diego, about 45 miles to the Mission/Fallbrook exit. Immediately upon exiting the freeway turn right and then right again on to Mission. Go 7 miles into Fallbrook on Mission. At Pico Ave. turn right... this becomes De Luz (you will be almost at the end of Mission). Go 1 mile out of town (downhill) to a "Y" in the road. Turn left at the "Y" and the within 40-50 feet turn right into the Santa Margarita Equine Staging Area. Approximately 60 miles from Norco.
