
# Casino Night 2020

# **Proposed Vehicle Code Change**

In 2018 California changed its license requirements for towing vehicles. Most people have a basic Class C license. That license used to allow most drivers to haul their horses for recreational purposes.

The licensing changes required a driver to possess a Class A License when towing any trailer over 10,000 pounds GVWR. This change impacted the horse community because many living quarters weighed over 10,000 pounds.

On February 20, 2019, California Senate Bill No. 415 was proposed by Senator Shannon Grove. This bill proposes amending the Vehicle Code. It would define the term "recreational trailer" as a vehicle that is designed to be towed by a motor vehicle and used for human habitation, to carry horses and other animals, to carry recreational equipment and off-highway vehicles, or some combination of these uses, for recreational purposes.

This bill would authorize a person with a class C license to tow a recreational trailer weighing no more than 10,000 pounds or, if the person has passed a written examination, a recreational trailer weighing more than 10,000 pounds but not exceeding 15,000 pounds.


