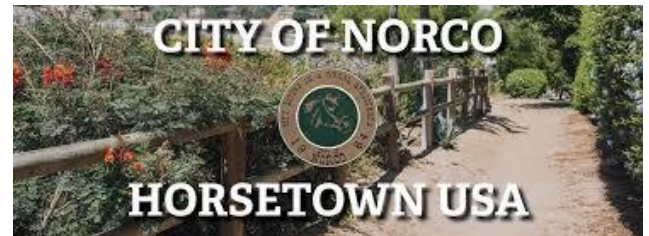

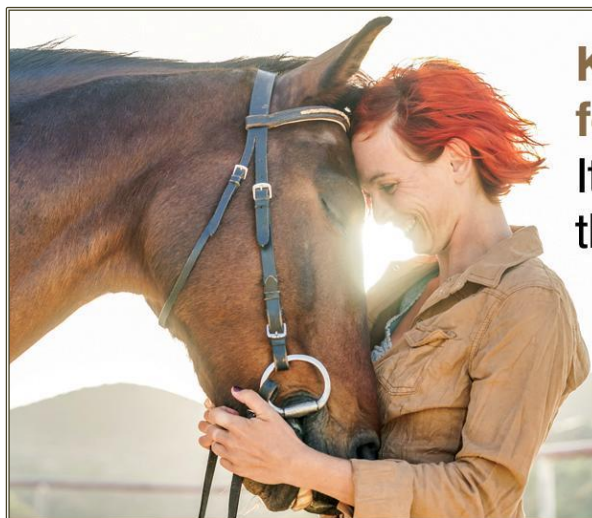
Our Top Ten list has not changed a lot, but we did add one item to the list. You probably have seen that all the wood fencing on Sixth Street is being removed and the white vinyl fence is being installed. While many prefer the wood fence, the white vinyl fence seems to be much more visible at night. Maybe people will see it and not hit it as often.

Our request is that they bring the fencing all the way to Ingalls Park. At this time the fencing ends at Crestview. Then there is a piece of fence in front of Pike's Peak Park and then no fencing as your ride into the arena or take the trail to Pumpkin Rock. We would like to see the fence extended into Ingalls Park. This addition would add safety for riders or people walking and it would finish off that area which is a show piece of this city.


