Open Riding Returns to Ingalls

Ingalls has re-opened for recreational riding!

The city has announced that open riding will resume at Ingalls Center's Clark Arena. When available, riders can use the 98,000-square-foot covered open-air arena Mondays thru Wednesdays from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

If you interested in going, you can only enter at Gate 7. That gate opens at 10:00 AM. You must wear a mask and maintain social distancing; 6 feet between people and 10 feet between horse trailers. Check the City's website before you go to ensure the arena is open.

Only three riders are allowed in the arena for 30 minute sessions. This may seem restrictive, but normally it is not crowded. Riders can work their horses as long as they want if no one else is waiting.

We are so fortunate to live in Norco where this type of facility is available to the public.


